

FCC Radio Contest Rules for Listeners

Guidelines for Participating in Radio Contests

General Rules

- All contests must comply with Federal Communications Commission (FCC) regulations and applicable local laws.
- Listeners must be at least 18 years old or have parental consent to participate where required.
- Employees of the radio station, their immediate families, and sponsors are not eligible to win.

How to Enter

- Contest entry methods will be clearly announced on air and/or posted on the station's website.
- Only one entry per person per contest is allowed unless otherwise specified.

Winner Selection

- Winners will be chosen according to the criteria outlined in the contest announcement (e.g., random drawing, correct answer, etc.).
- All decisions by the station are final and binding.

Prizes

- Winners are responsible for all taxes and fees associated with prize receipt and/or use.

Disqualification

- Any attempt to tamper with the contest process or violate these rules may result in disqualification.
- False or misleading information provided by a participant will result in forfeiture of prizes.

Additional Terms

- By participating, listeners agree to allow the station to use their name, voice, and likeness for promotional purposes.
- The station reserves the right to modify, suspend, or cancel contests at any time for any reason.
